



Steps For Your Congregation Participation

Coordinating a campaign in the congregation is simple, and we will walk through the steps with you.

- STEP 1:** Receive a presentation to your Council through the Council Visit Video, which is approximately 15 minutes in total. Campaign staff are available to attend your council meeting if helpful.
- STEP 2:** Select a Congregation Leader or appoint your Stewardship Team to conduct this campaign. In some cases, Lutheridge will suggest a leader for you.
- STEP 3:** Arrange for your Congregation Leader to attend a Congregation Leader Training Event. Congregation Leaders will be given a full manual, complete training, and receive printed and digital materials in quantities sufficient for your congregation's membership. Training dates are happening each month. Visit Lutheridge.org/campaign to sign up.
- STEP 4:** Your congregation sets a three-year financial goal for your campaign. (This step can be completed immediately following or during the Council Visit – Step 1)
- STEP 5:** Your congregation conducts a four-week financial gifts campaign culminating in the seeking of three-year pledges from families of the congregation. Alternative options to a 4-5 week mini-campaign that still encourages your congregation's participation will be provided at the Leader Training as well.
- STEP 6:** Once gifts/pledges have been received at the end of the four-week gifts Campaign (or alternative process), they will be collected at your congregation and then shared with the camp. The camp will handle all bookkeeping and acknowledgments.
