As a Director, I can attest that many times the level given to a piece does not tell the whole story for that piece. While there are L2 pieces on this list, we can do so much more with them as advanced ringers! Kevin has plans to really work on and bring out the opportunity for musicality in these pieces. (Yep, I used the 'm' word on the repertoire list!)

Be prepared for the same wonderful time working with the clinicians, ringing our bells, and having fellowship within our choirs. Be prepared for some changes that C19 may require:

- Adjusted schedule
- Different approach to classes offered
- Limited mingling/interaction between choirs

One last significant change in 2021 is that Jeffers Handbell Supply will NOT be with us. Jeffers has suspended its traveling stores until at least the summer. They have expressed their disappointment in not joining us in 2021 and look forward to when they can return to full operations again.
